In 1993, the discipline was awarded the doctoral degree of foreign linguistics and applied linguistics. In 2003, the Ministry of Personnel approved the establishment of a post doctoral station of foreign language and literature. In 2010, the discipline was granted the right to confer a doctoral degree in the first level discipline of foreign language and literature.

There are 25 professors (including 2 distinguished professor and 9 long-term professors), 66 associate professors (including 1 long-term associate professor and 50 master's supervisors. The number of teachers with doctoral degrees accounts for 69% of the total number of teachers.

The School of Foreign Languages (SFL) now consists of several teaching and research institutes, including four departments (English Department, Japanese Department, Ger Department, Department of Translation and Interpreting), three divisions (French and Russian Division, College English Division, and Postgraduate College English Division), 10 research institutes and centers, and editorial offices ocontemporary Foreign Language Studies, Journal of Second Language Studies, and Frontiers of Narrative Studies. The National College English Testing (CET) was designed and delivered by SJTU professors in the 1980s, and the CET committee is also based in SFL, SJTU.

- 1. The topic selection and content of the dissertation are generally determined by the tutor within the scope of the first level discipline of Foreign Language and Literature. For the requirements of the form, please refer to the format Requirements of the Postgraduate Dissertation of the School of Foreign Languages, Shanghai Jiao Tong University;
- 2. Requirements for doctoral students to apply for pre defense:

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- (1) Complete all the courses of the training plan, pass the examination and reach the required total credits;
- (2) Pass the thesis opening and mid-term examination;
- (3) Complete the first draft of the dissertation and pass the supervisor's review.
- 3. The pre oral defense of doctoral thesis is usually conducted three months before the oral defense; after the pre oral defense is completed, the thesis can be modified according to modification suggestions put forward by the expert committee of the pre oral defense. After the modification is completed and approved by the tutor, the thesis can be applied for rev and spot check with the repetition rate of no more than 15%;
- 4. Paper review and spot check are usually conducted two months before the defense;
- 5.After the papers pass the review and sampling inspection, the application for defense can be submitted one week before the defense, and the defense can be conducted after the approval of the Department.
